# Prayers for a New Year of Light - Pastor Mike Mirakian

Each new year begins during the cold, dark days of winter. Perhaps that's why people often celebrate with fireworks and sparkling decorations, lighting up the midnight sky with festive radiant colors. I'm usually asleep before the ball drops in Times Square, but I do appreciate the thought of spreading light into the darkness as we celebrate the dawn of a new year.

Perhaps we can make 2025 a year of light. Light that overcomes darkness. Light that fills people with hope. Light that reveals truth and goodness.

Jesus calls us to "let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven" (Matthew 5:16).

Let me invite you to pray in the coming days – maybe all year long – for God's light to shine brightly in our world. Here are some ways to pray that 2025 will be a year of light:

Ask God to keep our church focused on the mission of sharing Jesus' love and message with the world. Jesus tells us to put our light on stand and let it shine for all to see. We reflect God's glorious light as we fellowship together, love our neighbors and share the good news of our Savior.

Lift up the Church, here at home and throughout the world. Ask God to bless, protect and strengthen His people so they can spread His light into every corner of creation. Pray for missionaries who carry Jesus' message, for churches in faraway places and for our sister churches throughout the Covenant.

**Pray for yourself and your family**, that God's peace would flow in place of anxiety and fear. Ask God to fill you with the light of His truth, His hope and His grace. May our homes be places of light where we feel safe and cared for. May our families receive the assurance of God's blessing even as we seek to be a blessing to our neighbors.

**Ask God for wisdom.** Seek His ways instead of the world's. Fill your heart with the light of God's word so you can walk in His truth under the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

Through it all, pray that the light Jesus placed in our hearts will "shine before others." What we do, the words we say, even the values by which we lead our lives should allow God's grace and goodness to radiate from us. Don't hide the light away or put it under a bowl. Instead, put Jesus' light on a stand so everyone will see the glory of our Savior.

I pray that 2025 will be a joyful and blessed year for each of you and our church family.

Happy New Year from the Mission, Evangelism & Outreach Committee. This month please pray for Missionary Aviation Repair Center (MARC). "MARC started as an organized aviation maintenance facility for Alaskan missions in 1964 by Roald and Harriett Amundsen. Within a year, God provided a Cessna 180 and led them to provide not only quality maintenance, but also safe, efficient, and economical transportation for missionaries who did not have their own aircraft. Today with more than 230 villages inaccessible except by sea or air, Alaska has unique ministry concerns, and it's the remote nature of the people they need to reach that necessitates their aviation ministry. Alaska is also a place of pronounced spiritual and physical needs exaggerated by isolation and harsh conditions. Their purpose is to serve God there. MARC's mission is to expand the reach of the Gospel in Alaska by: Flying people and supplies where there are no roads; Supporting other missionaries and their aircraft; and Training missionary-minded pilots and mechanics."
